Sanchez Art Center (SAC) seeks artists (18 and older) from California, Oregon, Washington, and Alaska for its *2019 Left Coast Annual*, April 12 – May 19, 2019. Online entries only. Enter at www.CallForEntry.org.

ENTRY DEADLINE: Tues, January 29

Entries must be submitted online by 11 pm Pacific Standard Time. Enter early to avoid last-minute problems!

ABOUT THE ONLINE PROCESS

To find the online application:

Go to www.CallForEntry.org. Click on “View All Calls.” Scroll through the names list to “2019 Left Coast Annual,” and click on name for complete info.

TO ENTER:

If you are not already registered with CaFE™, go to www.CallForEntry.org and register. CaFE™ provides artists with an easy-to-use system to create a profile with contact information, upload digital images of your artwork, and apply to a number of open calls for entry at one time. There is no cost to register your profile, and you can update it at any time. Your unique login information allows you complete access to a number of open calls that you can apply to from any Internet-connected computer.

Images uploaded to CaFE™ must be jpegs, at least 1200 ppi on the longest side, and under 5 MB. Videos of 3D works will also be accepted. See “Media Prep” on CaFE™ website for complete jpeg and video uploading requirements.

IMPORTANT: You can save your pending entry and revisit it, but **once you finalize and submit your entry, it cannot be changed.**

ELIGIBILITY

Open to all California, Oregon, Washington, and Alaska artists age 18 and older. All fine arts visual media will be considered. Artwork shown in prior juried exhibitions at Sanchez Art Center is not eligible. Work must be able to fit through a standard-sized door (80” x 35”) and weigh less than 50 lbs. Framed 2D work must be wired (no sawtooth hangers). Other display methods may be used only if approved by Sanchez Art Center, and the artist must supply any special hardware. We reserve the right to refuse works not accurately represented by the digital images submitted.

ENTRY FEES

Each artist may submit up to 20 images. The non-refundable fee **for each image** entered (including detail shots if you feel these are important) is \$15 (i.e., the fee is \$30 for 2 images, \$45 for 3, etc.). CaFE™ accepts Visa and Mastercard. Checks should be made payable to and mailed to Sanchez Art Center well before entry deadline.

SALES

Sales are encouraged. SAC retains a 30% commission on any works sold. Artists should include the 30% commission in their sales prices. Sales tax will be administered by SAC.

GALLERY SITTING

Each artist is encouraged to gallery sit from 1 to 3 pm or 3 to 5 pm for one day (Friday–Sunday) during the show.

SHIPPING & RETURN OF ACCEPTED ARTWORKS

Shipped work must arrive at SAC by 5 pm on Thursday, April 4. Artists are responsible for all shipping costs. Shipped work must be sent with a **prepaid return shipping label** inside the package. We will re-use your packaging for returns. **Make sure your shipping company will pick up at Sanchez Art Center, as we cannot deliver packages to shippers.**

LIABILITY

Sanchez Art Center carries \$150,000 art insurance for damage or theft, subject to a \$500 deductible for which the Art Center will not be liable. The artist agrees to abide by and accept the terms and conditions of the policy and to release Sanchez Art Center, its Board of Directors, staff, volunteers, and agents; the Art Guild of Pacifica; and the City of Pacifica from any further liability.

ARTIST COMMITMENT

By submitting your work, you agree that the work will be available during the exhibition dates listed, and that you will deliver and pick up your work on the dates specified. Alternate work may not be substituted for work selected by the juror. You also grant Sanchez Art Center permission to use images of accepted works for public relations, marketing, and archival purposes.
